Also, **please review the enclosed River Falls Days Parade Policy Snapshot**. We created these guidelines based on feedback from participants, spectators, and marching band coordinators. Our goal is to keep the parade moving at a steady pace so it is more enjoyable for everyone. **** If your parade unit includes animals, you must provide your own clean up crew immediately following their unit. Units without waste removal equipment will be moved to the end of the parade.**

If your group still needs to hand in waivers or parade announcements, please send them to the Chamber Office by July 7th, 2008 or bring them to the parade. A waiver form is included here for your convenience. Please note: Announcements that are handed in the day of the parade are not guaranteed to be read during the parade.

Directions to the River Falls Days Parade Line-Up: Exit from either Hwy 35 or Hwy 65 to Main St at the North end of River Falls. Proceed south into town. A parade volunteer will be available to direct you to your line-up location.

RIVER FALLS DAYS PARADE POLICY SNAPSHOT

Responding to feedback from spectators and marching band coordinators we are implementing a new parade policy. Please review this carefully and observe these rules so we can continue to maintain a safe, high-quality parade for participants and spectators. Thank you for your cooperation and your participation.

Please share this information with the float driver and all participants of the float.

- Maintain steady, forward motion throughout the parade route, except in cases where safety may be in an issue.
- Parade speed varies; maintain a distance of no more than one-half block between your unit and the one in front of you (or up to one full block, if the unit in front of yours is a school marching band). Immediately close any gaps that are created.
- Walkers must keep up with the unit; moving vehicles cannot wait for walkers.
- Candy or other give-aways must not be thrown from moving vehicles.
- **All entries with livestock must have their own waste removal equipment immediately following their unit. Units without waste removal equipment will be moved to the end of the parade.**
- Drivers of motorized vehicles **must** be at least 16 years of age and have a valid drivers' license.
- If a marching band is in the Judging Area on 2nd Street, you may not enter it until the marching band has exited **completely**.
- **Horns, sirens or excessively loud sounds of any kind** are prohibited while a marching band is in the Judging Area.
- Your unit may pause in front of the Reviewing Stand at 2nd and Elm for **no more than** 30 seconds.
- Spraying water from squirt guns, hoses, etc., toward the Reviewing Stand is strictly prohibited.

Your full cooperation with Parade Officials in the staging area and along the entire parade route will be expected. The Chamber and/or Parade Officials reserve the right to remove parade units at any time for failure to comply with any portion of the parade policy.
